INDEPENDENT TEMPORARY LIVING STEPS

- 1. Acquire a physician's statement.
- 2. Draw up a plot plan of the lot, including permanent house and temporary house, driveway.
- 3. Take the plot plan to the Health Department. You will be required to file a variance for this temporary residence which will be approved/disapproved by the Clinton County Board of Health. Once the variance has been approved, you will most likely have to apply for a Site Evaluation to have the current septic system added on to or a new septic system installed for the temporary residence. There is a cost associated with the Site Evaluation. Once the Site Evaluation has been applied for, the plot plan can be signed and approved.
- 4. Bring all of the above to the Zoning Department for application.
- 5. Schedule for a conditional use meeting.
- 6. Purchase building and zoning permits for temporary housing.
- 7. Call for appropriate inspections to set the temporary home.
- 8. Upon receipt of the certificate of occupancy, resident is ready to occupy the home.
