The **Nike Center** is located at 4425 State Route 730, approximately four miles south-west of Wilmington. Our sixteen acre campus was once the control area for Nike Ajax and Nike Hercules missiles, and served as the Cincinnati/Dayton Area Defense Command Headquarters from 1959 through 1971, for the Army Air Defense Command. The federal government made the property available to Clinton County in 1972, specifically for use by the Board of DD. Following renovations, Board programs were moved to the **Nike Center** in 1974.

Since 1967 the Clinton County Board of Developmental Disabilities (**Nike Center**) has been providing needed services to our county's citizens and their families. During these years the array of services and supports for people with disabilities has grown.

Currently the **Nike Center** touches the lives of over 400 people with disabilities in our county. A lifetime of services are offered from the time an infant is diagnosed with a developmental disability, or at any age prior to twenty –two, if an incident should occur that results in disability. The voters of Clinton County remain generous in their support of our programs and services.

As we look to the future, the one thing that will remain the same is that the **Nike Center** will continue to provide those we serve with opportunities to

and participate as equal citizens in their communities.

## **WORK**

**Orion Rehabilitation Center** provides year-round sheltered employment serving citizens with disabilities from throughout the county.

**Community Employment** provides people with disabilities a chance to work in typical employment settings while providing valuable human resources to employers such as Kroger's, Liberty Savings Bank, Frisch's Restaurant and Generations Pizza.

**Home-Based Work** may be provided for individuals who are unable to work in the community or sheltered workshops.

**Retirement Services** have been developed to continue quality of life during life's later years.

**Transportation** to Adult Services Programs and some special activities is available using our fleet of buses and vans.

## **PLAY**

**Special Olympics** allow youth and adult athletes with developmental disabilities to compete and excel in sports such as track and field, bowling, basketball and cheerleading.

**Social Events** are held in the community and at the **Nike Center** throughout the year including holiday luncheons, activity days, dances and parties.

**Community Activities and Field Trips** encourage interaction and development in community settings.

## **LIVE**

**Service and Support Administration** assures that eligible individuals receive quality services and choice, whether county board or from a private service provider, that make a full life possible.

**Residential Supports** help meet the specific needs of individuals to live in the community. Supports range from drop-by services to around the clock assistance.

**Family Support Services** assist with equipment, respite care or other things needed to help the individual remain in the family setting.

**Nursing Services** are offered during the day at the **Nike Center** to aid in maintaining the health of all individuals served. Our residential providers also offer nursing services.

**Non-Vocational Services** are offered to meet our clients' interests.

## **LEARN**

**Early Intervention's** focus is on treatment of suspected disability early in the life of children ages 0 to 3. Both in-home and site-based services are offered.

**School Age Service Coordination and Transition Services** are provided for all children with multiple disabilities in the county's four public school districts.

**Summer Habilitation Program** at Adult Services is offered to DD eligible children who are at least 16 years of age.

**Habilitation Services** for adults are provided as needed by Adult Services.
