

**CLINTON COUNTY JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES  
FOSTER CARE PROGRAM  
POLICY OF CHILD AND TEENAGE MOTHER'S CIVIL RIGHTS**

In accordance with Rule 5101:2-5-35(A)(36), of the Ohio Administrative Code, Clinton County Job and Family Services assures protection of a child's or teenage mother's rights in so much as Clinton County Job and Family Services shall follow all mandates as described in the Ohio Administrative Code and Ohio Revised Code which requires public children service agencies to look after the interests of children in need of public care or protection. The agency shall administer such services securing the care and protection of children and their rights while at all times receiving supervision and monitoring from the State and Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.

The instances where children are in temporary custody or permanent custody; guardian ad litem, attorneys, judges, probation officers, and various other court personnel shall provide additional supervision and monitoring to ensure that children's as well as teenage mother's civil rights are protected in all matters.
