FOSTER CHILD OVERNIGHT POLICY

Foster Parents must review the policy carefully. Once the policy information is distributed, they will be responsible to follow the policy.

Overnight Stays

The caseworker for the requesting child must have 48 hours notice prior to the overnight for approval.

The caseworker for the requesting child is responsible for explaining the overnight policy to potential caregivers.

All adults who reside in the potential caregiver's home will comply with the following activities:

- Signed release of information for Children Services, criminal and Juvenile Court check.
- Provide fingerprints for criminal check.
- Comply with a walk through safety check of the home.
- If transporting, provide valid driver's license and insurance. Copy must be maintained in the permanent file.
