FOSTER CHILD SMOKING POLICY

Foster Parents must review the policy carefully. Once the policy information is distributed, they will be responsible to follow the policy.

Smoking

No foster child under the age of 18 is permitted to use any tobacco product. The following policy also addresses the issue of second hand smoke in a foster care setting.

Foster children will not be directly exposed to any second hand smoke while in a foster home.

Foster children will not be exposed to second hand smoke while riding in a vehicle.

If anyone in the foster home chooses to smoke while a foster child is placed in their home, second hand smoke cannot directly affect the foster child.
