FOSTER CHILD SEMI-ANNUAL REVIEW POLICY

Foster Parents must review the policy carefully. Once the policy information is distributed, they will be responsible to follow the policy.

SAR

Each child 16 years of age or older will be notified of Semi-Annual Reviews unless it has been determined to be detrimental to the child.

The caseworker does not need to obtain parental consent for the child to attend.

The foster child will be given an opportunity to participate in the case review process and have questions answered about the case.

If a determination has been made not to include a foster child in the SAR, justification must be documented in the permanent case record.

The child's best interest should always be the paramount concern when making the determination to include or not include the foster child in the SAR process.
