The fifth phase, which includes IO, Level One and Self-Waiver program services billed to DODD, will officially go into effect on October 1. 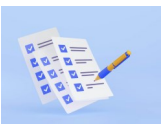

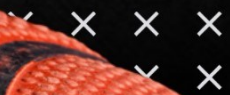
