DODD GUIDANCE

PSM BLACKOUT

As was announced in May 2022, the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) will roll out the single-entry Provider Network Module (PNM) in October 2022. DODD's Provider Services Management (PSM) system is undergoing modifications that will allow it to directly interface with PNM, which will become the single-entry point for all DODD providers. As a result, most features within PSM have already been suspended.

On 8/24/2022, the final two activities that currently remain open in PSM will be suspended. Those two functions are:

- Voluntary Withdrawal of currently pending applications, and
- Self-Service applications (i.e., email and phone number updates, etc.) As of 8/24/2022, PSM will remain unavailable until the new Provider Network Module becomes available in October 2022.

PNM PREREGISTRATION

Providers with an existing Medicaid number and OH|ID will not need to preregister [i.e., Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD)]. prior to October 1st. If you have already completed Pre-Registration, it will not impact anything and you will be all set for go-live on October 1st!
