## RECERTIFICATION

## **INFORMATION**

Your initial certification is valid for 3 years.

When your certification is approaching expiration, you must apply for recertification. You can start applying up to 90 days in advance of expiration. **BEST PRACTICE is to start the application as soon as you are able to in order to prevent delays in reimbursement and/or service provision.**

## WHAT IS REQUIRED FOR RECERTIFICATION?

- Current background check (BCI) if not enrolled in RapBack (Most providers are enrolled in RapBack, if you are not sure, contact Provider Support)
  - FBI background check if not a resident of Ohio for the last 5 years, regardless of RapBack enrollment
- CPR/First Aid Certification (current)
- Completion of annual required training
- ➤ Updated copy of State ID

  IF YOU ARE CERTIFIED IN TRANSPORTATION, YOU ALSO WILL NEED:
- Current copy of Driver's License
- > Current copy of Car Insurance
- Current Driver's Abstract, dated within 14 days of the date you are submitting your application
  - \* Additional information may need to be submitted depending on the services you are certified to provide\*
