PURPOSE AND GUIDELINES FOR VARIANCES

A Variance approved by the Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) must satisfy the following basic conditions:

- 1. Where the property in question will yield a reasonable return or whether there can be any beneficial use of the property without the variance;
- 2. Whether the variance is substantial;
- 3. Whether the essential character of the neighborhood would be substantially altered or whether adjoining properties would suffer substantial detriment as a result of the variance;
- 4. Whether the variance would adversely affect the delivery of governmental services;
- 5. Whether the property owner's predicament feasibly can be obviated through some method other than a variance; and
- 6. Whether the spirit and intent behind the zoning requirement would be observed and substantial justice done by granting a variance.
