Ohio's COVID-19 Vaccine Town Halls

There are a lot of myths about COVID-19 vaccines. Ohio's COVID-19 Town Halls will help answer questions and provide access to accurate information about vaccines. Hear from medical experts, community leaders, and public health professionals. Watch livestreams on Facebook, YouTube, and at coronavirus.ohio.gov/townhall at the following dates and times:

- Monday, March 1, 6:30 p.m. – Asian American and Pacific Islander Ohioans
- Tuesday, March 2, 6:30 p.m. – Rural Ohioans

When can I get my COVID-19 vaccine? Ohioans eligible:

- ✓ Age 65+
- ✓ Those with severe congenital or developmental disorders and medical conditions listed in the [Priority Populations Fact Sheet](#).
- ✓ Employees of K-12 schools.
- ✓ [Ohioans born with or who have early childhood conditions that are carried into adulthood](#), which put them at a higher risk for adverse outcomes due to COVID-19, may choose to receive the vaccine at the provider of their choice, but will be asked by their vaccine provider to confirm that they are, in fact, eligible at this time.

INDUSTRY INFORMATION

■ Governor DeWine announced there will be updates to the guidelines for sporting and entertainment venues, which will include safety protocols. More information will be released the week of March 1. New guidance for proms, banquets, wedding receptions, fairs, festivals and parades will be forthcoming.

■ Do you have employees who may be eligible for COVID-19 vaccines at this time? Help them prepare for their appointment using this [fact sheet to guide patients through the process – before, during, and after vaccination](#).

■ Individuals who believe their identity was stolen and used to file a fraudulent unemployment claim can visit unemployment.ohio.gov, click on the "Report Identity Theft" button and follow the guidance for individuals. This includes three steps: 1. Complete the reporting form, 2. File your taxes using IRS guidance, and 3. Protect your identity.

TALKING POINTS FOR YOU

- COVID-19 vaccines are scarce, and we must be patient while demand for the vaccine remains higher than the available supply. As vaccine supply increases, more and more Ohioans in Phase 1B will be able to be vaccinated.
- Trust the facts: the COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective. COVID-19 vaccines currently available in the U.S. were rigorously tested and do not give you COVID-19 or cause a positive COVID-19 test.
- We have to do all that we can to continue protecting ourselves and others from contracting and spreading COVID-19. It's important that we continue to wash our hands regularly, maintain social distancing, and wear our masks anytime we are out with others.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

- ✓ Set a good example, by wearing a mask, making virtual accommodations, and maintaining social distance when meeting face-to-face with others.
- ✓ Post on social media to describe how you are working to keep your employees and customers safe (and what they can do to help you maintain a safe environment) using the suggested hashtags.
- ✓ Submit letters to the editor or local news outlets that support the "COVID-19 Key Messages;" wear a mask, wash hands often, and social distance.
- ✓ Participate in local media/radio interviews to support "COVID-19 Key Messages," and help showcase how you and your colleagues in the industry are supporting Ohio's Responsible Restart.
