

INDEPENDENT TEMPORARY LIVING STEPS

1. Acquire a physician's statement.
2. Draw up a plot plan of the lot, including permanent house and temporary house, driveway.
3. Take the plot plan to the Health Department. You will be required to file a variance for this temporary residence which will be approved/disapproved by the Clinton County Board of Health. Once the variance has been approved, you will most likely have to apply for a Site Evaluation to have the current septic system added on to or a new septic system installed for the temporary residence. There is a cost associated with the Site Evaluation. Once the Site Evaluation has been applied for, the plot plan can be signed and approved.
4. Bring all of the above to the Zoning Department for application.
5. Schedule for a conditional use meeting.
6. Purchase building and zoning permits for temporary housing.
7. Call for appropriate inspections to set the temporary home.
8. Upon receipt of the certificate of occupancy, resident is ready to occupy the home.
